The programme unfolds over two chapters, each exploring ephemerality as a vessel for ancestral memory, cultural healing, corporeal experience, and ecological awareness, shaped by the shifting elements of water and air. Rooted in Eastern European folk traditions and informed by voices often excluded from mainstream climate discourse, this series asks: Can ephemeral arts—movement, sound, ritual—become spaces of remembrance?
