He is Doctor of history of tea ceremony, professor of the traditional Japanese Culture at the Kyoto University and writer of many books about tea ceremony. He usually appears in TV. He is director of the Company Oimatsu confectioner of "wagashi" (Japanese pastry), and Director of the Kodokan Foundation dedicated to the Japanese traditional art.

Aldo Tollini is a professor of classic Japanese culture at Ca' Foscari University and author of many books about Buddhism as well as Tea Ceremony in Japan, published by Einaudi.
